

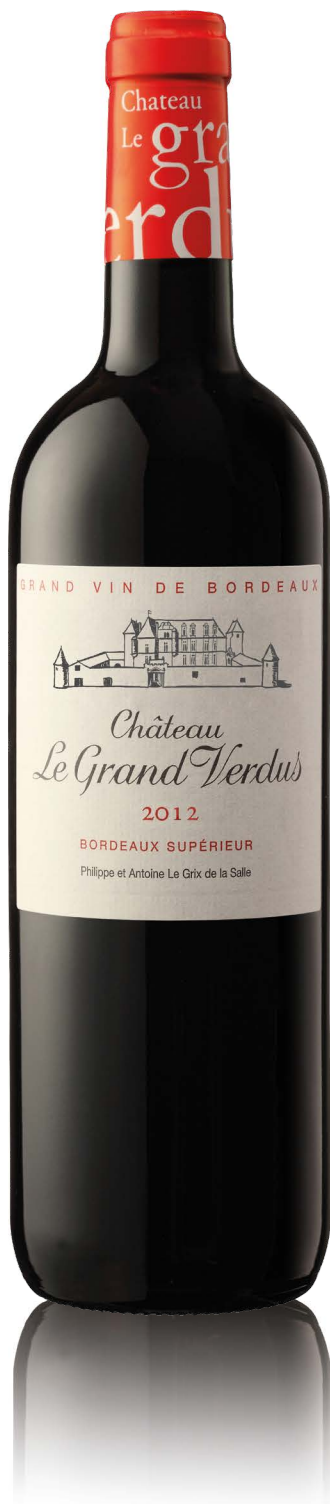
# Château Le Grand Verdu

## Bordeaux Supérieur



Château Le Grand Verdu, 115 hectares of vineyards, is in the heart of a hilly natural site of Entre Deux Mers, only 20km East of Bordeaux, near to Saint-Emilion. Since 1810, the « Le Grix de la Salle » family has been the owners of this superb Renaissance manor, dating 1579. A Château where the secret of genuine Bordeaux winemaking has been passed down from generation to generation. Today, it is Antoine and Thomas Le Grix de la Salle turn to continue this great heritage

Rich round with precise pure aromas. This wine reflects the many parcels of vines at Grand Verdu. It is intense and fresh, with numerous fragrances of red fruits, exotic spices and liquorice. Supple in the mouth and instantly pleasurable.



- **Blend :** 70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet-Franc

- **Vinification :** sorting table, stainless steel fermentation, limited yeast addition, moderate pumping-over and temperature (28°C) for smoother tannins. 20 days maceration in average. Gentle pneumatic pressing.

- **Ageing :** 16 to 20 months in stainless steel and concrete tanks. Limited racking to maintain a clean, bright fruit expression. Light fining before filtration.

- **Drink** over a 3 to 6 years period, with « bistrot » cuisine, poultry or grilled beef, under relaxed occasions.
