

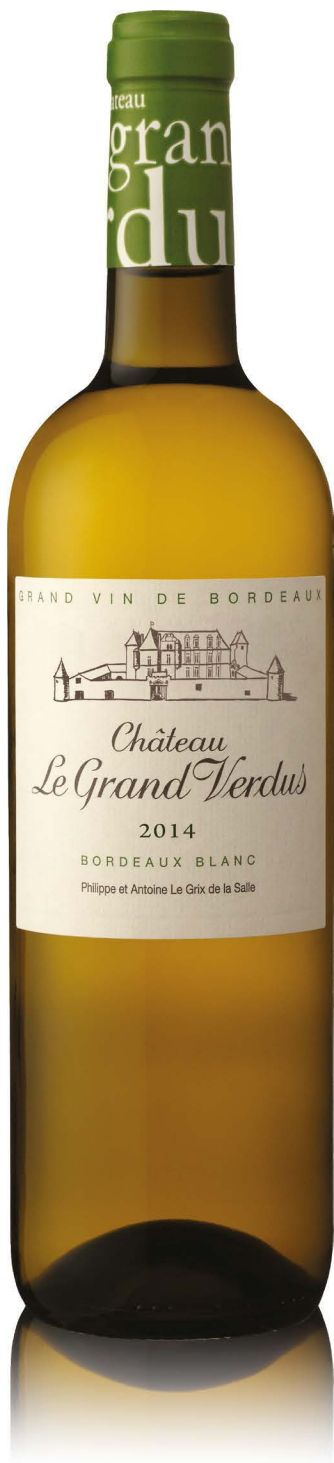
Château Le Grand Verdu

Bordeaux Blanc



Château Le Grand Verdu, 115 hectares of vineyards, is in the heart of a hilly natural site of Entre Deux Mers, only 20km East of Bordeaux, near to Saint-Emilion. Since 1810, the « Le Grix de la Salle » family has been the owners of this superb Renaissance manor, dating 1579. A Château where the secret of genuine Bordeaux winemaking has been passed down from generation to generation. Today, it is Antoine and Thomas Le Grix de la Salle turn to continue this great heritage.

Fresh and bright, with an enticing aromatic intensity. It is seductive, with delightful fruity notes hints of white flowers and peaches. The palate is pure, fresh, and possesses a long mineral intensity.



- **Blend :** **60% Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Sémillon, 10% Muscadelle**
- **Vinification :** night harvests to keep freshest potential fruit, sorting table, light maceration, long and gentle pneumatic pressing, stainless steel ferment with selected yeast at 16-18°C.
- **Ageing :** in stainless steel tanks, maximum prevention from oxidation, « batonnâgé sur lies » for 5 months. Limited sulfites additions.
- **Drink** over 2 to 3 years, for aperitif, to accompany summer salads, or more classical seafood, shellfish and goat cheese.
