Château Le Grand Verdus, 115 hectares of vineyards, is in the heart of a hilly natural site of Entre Deux Mers, only 20km East of Bordeaux, near to Saint-Emilion. Since 1810, the « Le Grix de la Salle » family has been the owners of this superb Renaissance manor, dating 1579. A Château where the secret of genuine Bordeaux winemaking has been passed down from generation to generation. Today, it is Antoine and Thomas Le Grix de la Salle turn to continue this great heritage.

Limited selection of our wine range, our “Réserve” is the last wine launched from our family line.

Loyal to our Chateau style, it intensely fruity, with beautiful nuances of black berries, tobacco, and a hint of toasty characters.

It has a round and savory palate, medium bodied, with round tannins and a long finish.



- **Blend :** **60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon**

- **Vinification :**

From our chalky clay terroirs, grapes are naturally grown and selected with a maximum of care.

- **Ageing :**

This wine is aged 50% in oak barrels, 50% in cement tanks during 12 months.

- **Drink over** a period of 5 to 8 years, preferably decanted. Best with a pork roast, beefsteak or a selection of cheese. As simple as that !
