

Château Le Grand Verdus

Bordeaux Rosé



Château Le Grand Verdus, 115 hectares of vineyards, is in the heart of a hilly natural site of Entre Deux Mers, only 20km East of Bordeaux, near to Saint-Emilion. Since 1810, the « Le Grix de la Salle » family has been the owners of this superb Renaissance manor, dating 1579. A Château where the secret of genuine Bordeaux winemaking has been passed down from generation to generation. Today, it is Antoine and Thomas Le Grix de la Salle turn to continue this great heritage.

Far from « classical » Bordeaux Rosé, this is a fine, light tannin style with a coral pink hue, obtained from only lightly pressing the grapes. Harvest occurs earlier in the season for better grapes balance. Highly aromatic with intense pure notes of fresh stone fruits and minerals.



- **Blend :** **50% Cabernet Franc, 30% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 20% Merlot**

- **Vinification :** night harvests to keep fruit potential, sorting table, no maceration, light pneumatic pressing, racking before stainless steel ferment with selected yeast at 16-18°C.

- **Ageing :** in stainless steel tanks maximum prevention from oxidation, « batonnage sur lies » for 4 months. Limited sulfites additions.

- **Drink** over 1 to 2 years, for aperitif, grilled meats and fish, or just when you feel like it !
